Lewis & Clark Conference Conference Amendment Proposal Volleyball Regular Season Matches

CURRENT:

Each division will play each member school in the division to determine divisional champion. The order of volleyball games will be C-B-A. A-team volleyball matches shall comply with the NSAA regulations. B-team volleyball matches shall be 2 out of 3 to 25 points with a cap of 27. The deciding game will go to 15 pts. C-team volleyball matches shall be 2 out of 3 to 21 points with a 23 point cap. The deciding game will go to 15 pts. B-team shall have a maximum of 11 minutes warm-up time. Division Conference standings will be determined by Conference Division win/loss records. In case of a tie, Conference Awards will be presented equally to top teams. All Conference contests shall begin at 5:30 pm (CBA) and 6:00 p.m. (BA). Triangular times shall be left up to the individual schools. One plaque shall be awarded to each regular season division champion.

Proposed: (Changes in Red)

Each division will play each member school in the division to determine divisional champion. The order of volleyball games will be C-B-A. A-team volleyball matches shall comply with the NSAA regulations. B-team volleyball matches shall be 2 out of 3 to 25 points with a cap of 27. The deciding game will go to 15 pts. C-team volleyball matches shall be 2 out of 3 to 21 points with a 23 point cap. The deciding game will go to 15 pts. B-team shall have a maximum of 11 minutes warm-up time. Division Conference standings will be determined by Conference Division win/loss records. In case of a tie, Conference Awards will be presented equally to top teams. All Conference contests shall begin at 5:00 pm (CBA) and 5:30 or 6 p.m. (BA)(determined by schools). Triangular times shall be left up to the individual schools. One plague shall be awarded to each regular season division champion.

Rationale:

A 5 p.m. start allows students, coaches, & spectators to return home earlier. Volleyball match lengths are very inconsistent. If matches run long, students are often gone late multiple nights a week. Travel times of 1 hour would allow most students to leave after or near the end of the school day to arrive 30 minutes prior to the "C" game.

Cost:

No cost or financial impact is expected because of this proposal.
